

# Melt & Pour Soap Kit

## Clear, Basic

*Using our ingredients bundle you can make two 500g soap blocks, using a variety of colours and fragrance oils, these can be adjusted using all kinds of fragrances and colours on our website to create your own unique soaps. This recipe starts by using only half of the ingredients. Please ensure all appropriate safety precautions are taken and PPE is worn when making this product.*



### A guide to making your own Melt & Pour Soaps

1. Firstly, prepare and clean your working area. Including sourcing all equipment needed. For this recipe we would recommend a microwaveable jug and a spatula.
2. Next, using your soap cutter provided, carefully cut half of your soap block into cubes. This will help speed up the melting process.
3. Then place your cubes into your jug and melt in the microwave on a medium heat. Preferably in intervals to ensure you don't boil your soap. Initially melt for one minute then stir and put back in. Keep an eye on your soap as it can get hot very fast.
4. Once your soap has melted completely, carefully add in your fragrance oil and stir well.
5. Next, you can colour your soap. This is totally down to preference, add a few drops of liquid colour and stir until completely blended. Trial this until you get your desired colour.
6. For this recipe idea we will add our botanicals to the soap mix. Sprinkle in your seeds and mix until dispersed throughout.
7. When you are happy, you can pour your soap mix into your loaf mould. If available, give it a spritz with isopropyl alcohol to remove any unwanted bubbles.
8. If adding your botanicals to the top of your soap bar you can sprinkle these on now. They may sink in slightly, if this isn't the desired affect leave to set a little then sprinkle on.
9. Then leave your soap to set, this will take a few hours to fully solidify.
10. Finally, once solidified remove your soap from the mould. Then you can repeat this recipe for your second block and enjoy your handmade soaps!
